**FARMS Rates from MCPS Schools at a Glance 2020-2021**

The Free and Reduced-price Meals System (FARMS) enrollment represents the percentage of students eligible for FARMS services at Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS). Residencies funded by the Arts & Humanities Council of Montgomery County (AHCMC) for the FY22 *Arts Residencies in Schools Grants* (ARSG) category must take place at a school with a school-wide FARMS rate greater than 35%. Schools highlighted in blue in the following document meet the 2020-2021 school year FARMS rate requirement for FY22 ARSG.

Alternatively, residencies may take place at a school with a school-wide FARMS rate less than 35% if the proposed residency will specifically serve students within a clearly defined program that serves ESOL students or students with disabilities, as listed on the school’s MCPS Schools at a Glance page.
