FARMS Rates from MCPS Schools at a Glance 2021-2022

The Free and Reduced-price Meals System (FARMS) rate represents the percentage of students eligible for FARMS services at Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS). Residencies funded by the Arts & Humanities Council of Montgomery County (AHCMC) for the FY23 *Arts Residencies in Schools Grants* (ARSG) category must take place at a school with a school-wide FARMS rate of 35% or more, as listed on the MCPS Schools at a Glance page. Schools highlighted in blue in the following document meet the 2021-2022 school year FARMS rate requirement for FY23 ARSG.

Alternatively, residencies may take place at a school with a school-wide FARMS rate less than 35% if the residency will specifically serve students within a clearly defined program that provides for ESOL students or students with disabilities, as listed on the school's MCPS Schools at a Glance page.
