FARMS Rates from MCPS Schools at a Glance 2022-2023

The Free and Reduced-price Meals System (FARMS) rate represents the percentage of students eligible for FARMS services at Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS). Residencies funded by the Arts & Humanities Council of Montgomery County (AHCMC) for the FY24 *Arts Residencies in Schools Grants* (ARSG) category must take place at a school with a school-wide FARMS rate of 35% or more, as listed on the MCPS Schools at a Glance page.
